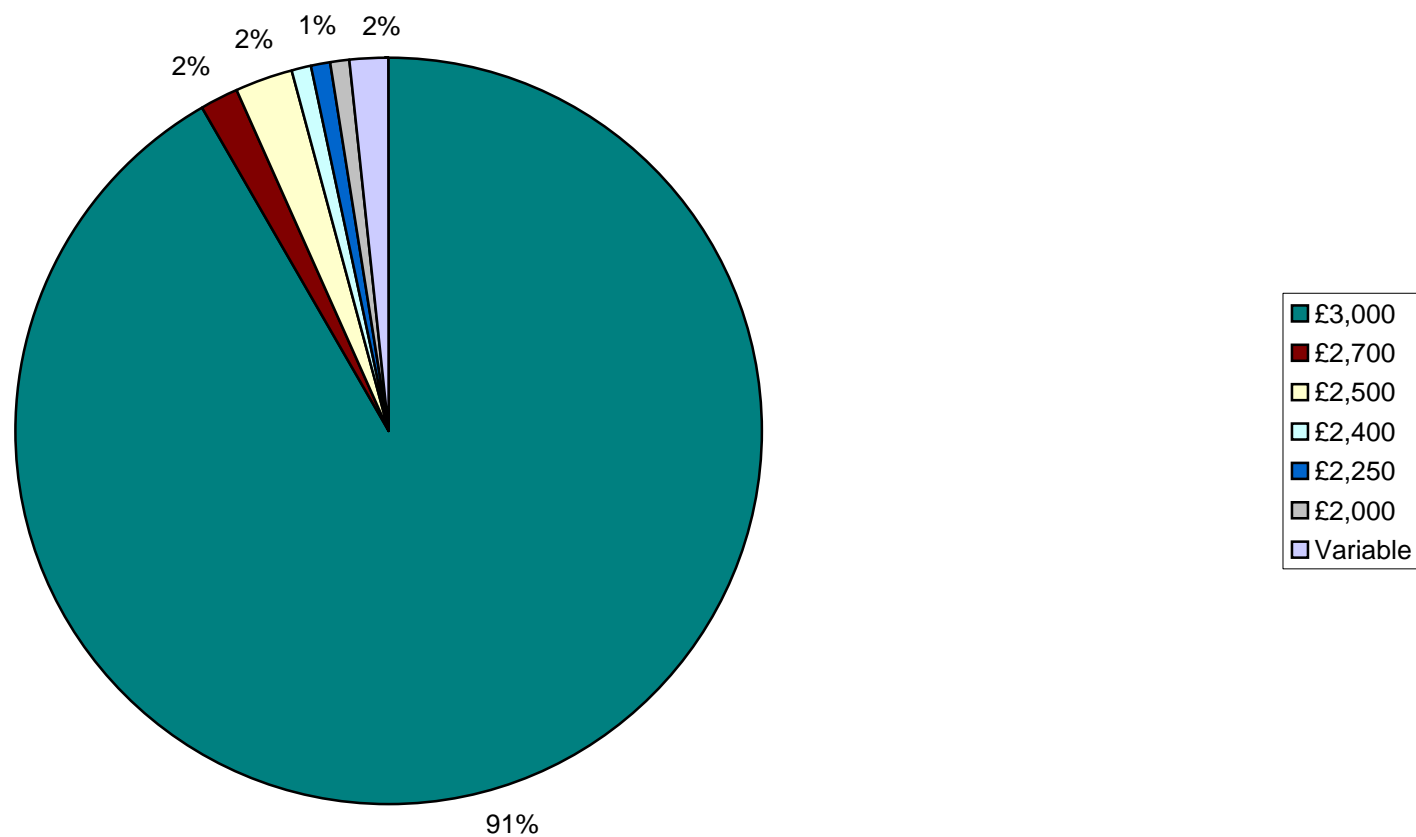
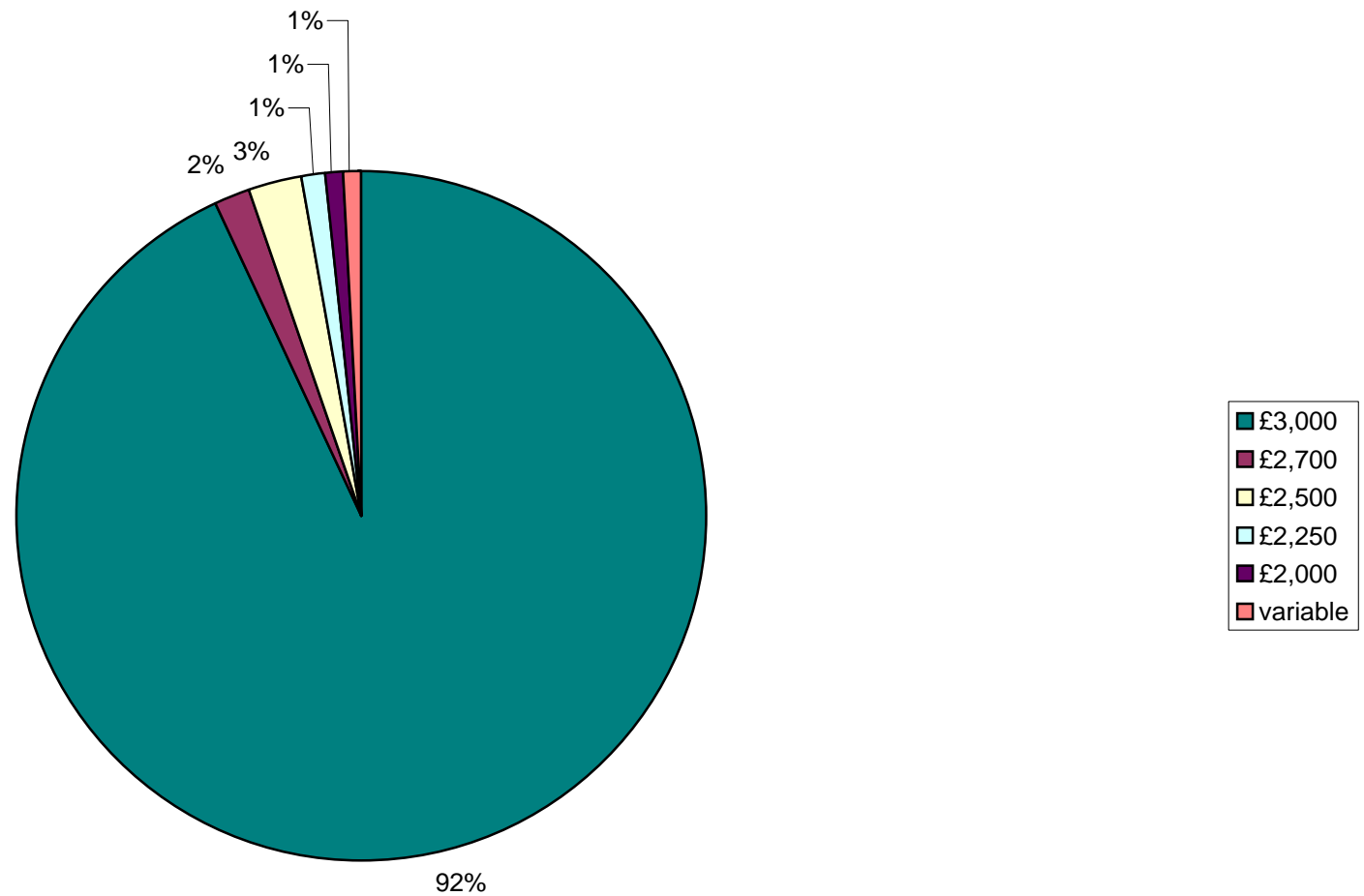


**GRAPH 1: Fee limits from 2006 for the Higher Education sector  
(for agreements assessed by 4 March 2005)**



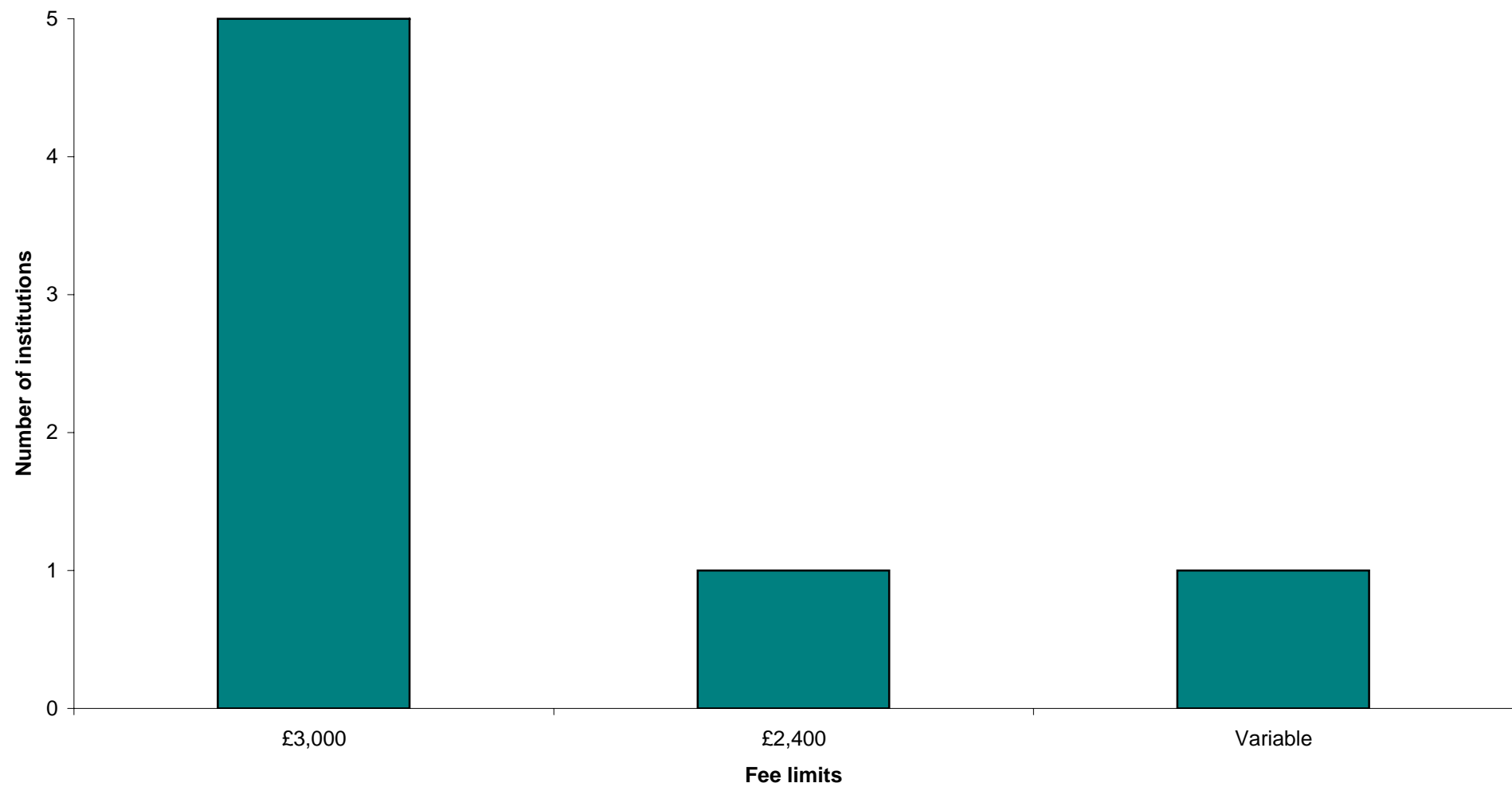
This is based on 120 directly funded institutions, including 7 FECs. HEIs may have indicated lower fee levels for franchise provision but this is not represented.

**(for agreements assessed by 4 March 2005)**

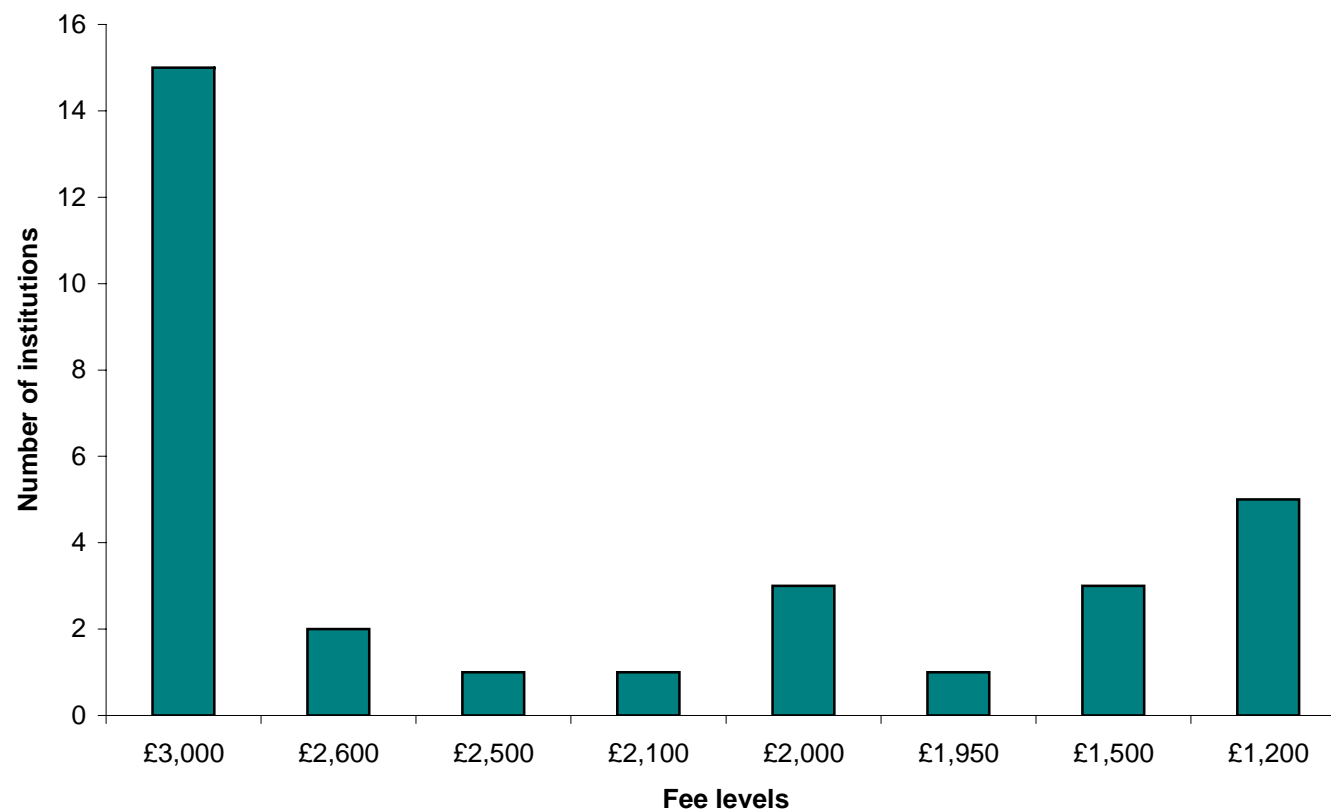


This is based on 109 HEIs

**(for agreements assessed by 4 March 2005)**

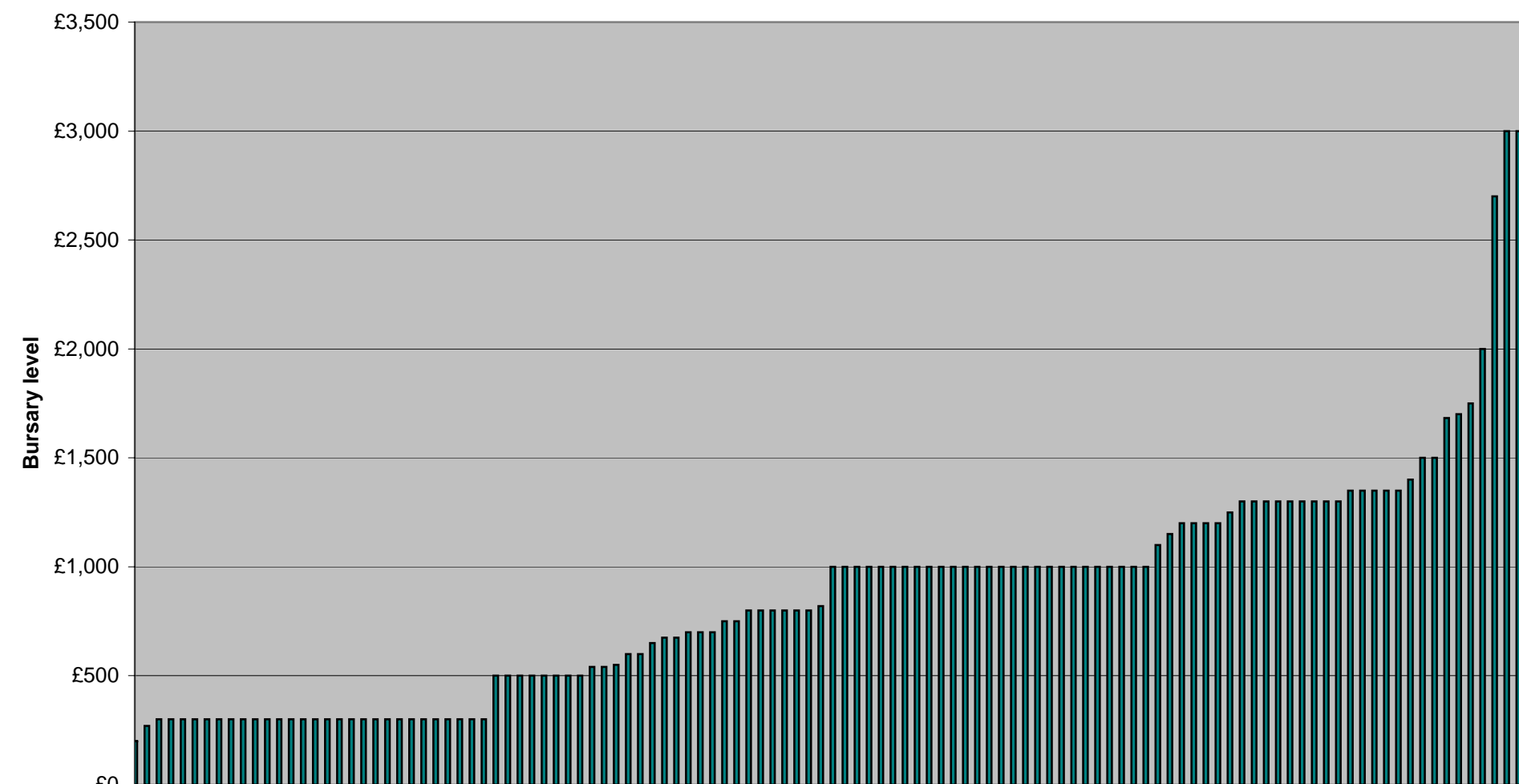


**GRAPH 4: FD/HND fee levels from 2006**

This is based on 31 institutions that have specifically referred to FD/HND provision in their agreements. Most institutions have specified £3,000 for all courses and this might include FD provision. It also doesn't take into account franchise arrangements.

**GRAPH 5: Bursary levels for students eligible for full state support from 2006  
(for agreements assessed by 4 March 2005 - includes HEIs and FECs)**



This represents the minimum that insitutions will be offering to students on full state support, many will offer more through additional criteria, scholarships etc
